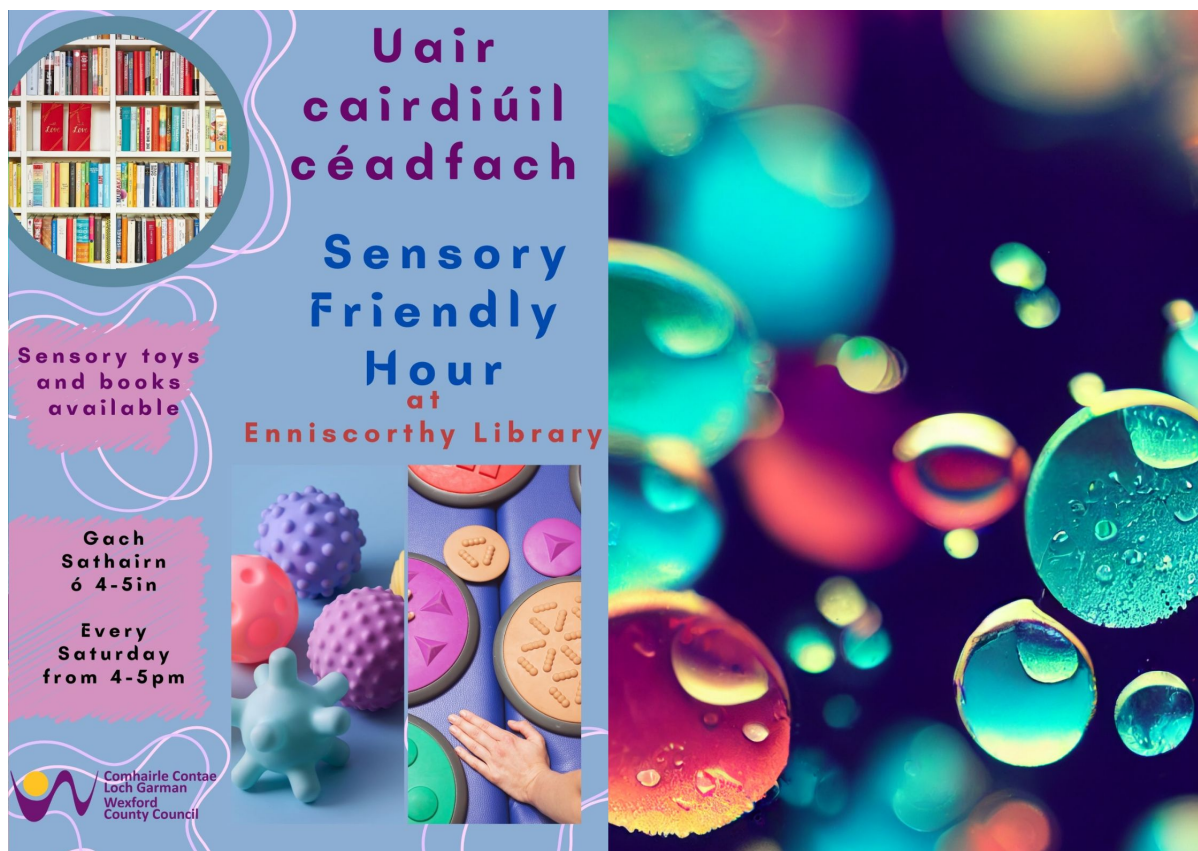


LEGO Free Play

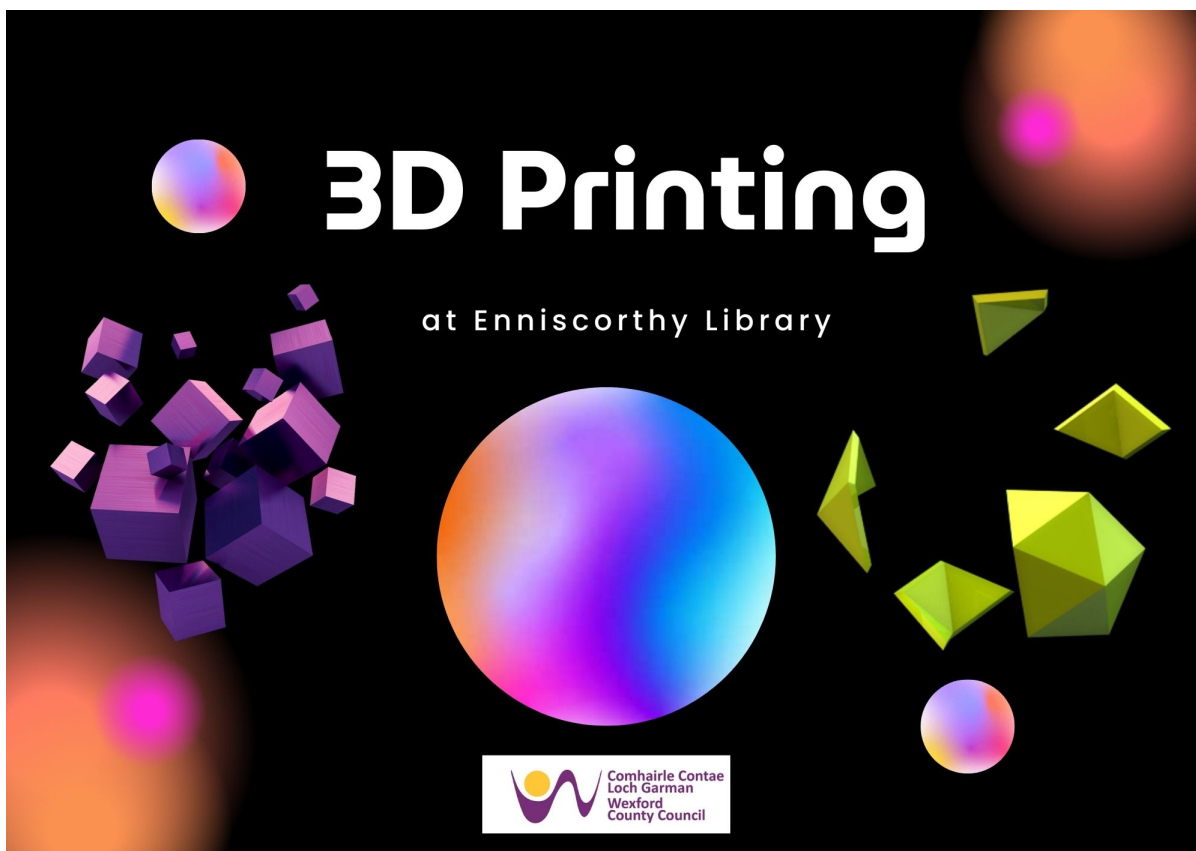


Radon Monitor
