

Dermot Byrne has performed in many of the Blackstairs Blues festivals including the very first festival in 1995.


He has built up a steady following over the years performing authentic renditions of classic blues and roots music as well as self-penned material.



Come along to Enniscorthy Library for an hour of conversation.



All day event


Libraries are open most days but on Saturday 27th of September we are issuing a special invitation to everyone in the country to come in and see everything that's on offer.


Sustainability and Environmental Awareness Workshop Discover a gardening approach that supports Sustainable Development Goals and has less impact on the environment.





Children will cut, stick, and decorate their own designs to create beautiful patterned pieces.


Each child will make two squares: one to take home and one to contribute to a large collaborative hanging decoration that will be displayed on the night.



All welcome and no booking required.




#### **LEGO Free Play**





The Sensory Toys and Assistive Resources (STAR) collection holds over 100 items and was developed to support children and young people with


#### **3D Printing at Enniscorthy Library**
