In this workshop, we will cover the following topics:

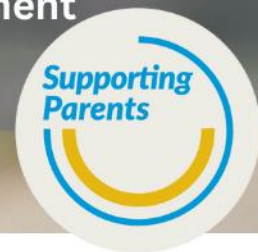
- Supporting Your Child,
