Certificate in Teaching Essential Literacies (TEL)

Module	Delivery Dates	Brief Descriptor
Adult Numeracy	1+2 Nov 15+16 Nov	This module aims to introduce students to the concept of numeracy within a social and cultural context and to become familiar with teaching and learning methodologies to effectively deliver numeracy to adult learners.
Developing Literacy 1	10+11 Jan 24+25 Jan	This module aims to give an understanding of, and practice in, the potential of literacy as a tool for personal and social transformation.
Digital Literacy in Adult and Further Education	7+8 Feb 28 Feb +1 Mar	This programme aims to give students an insight into some of the key digital technologies (including e-learning) and to their application to the teaching of adult literacy programmes. In particular, it aims to develop the skills required to effectively integrate digital technologies and ICT into curriculum development and allows students to experience the digital technologies central to the course as part of the learning process.
